



Origami is a felt rug created with a felt inlay and Punto Pettine stitching.

The rug's surface is divided into cm 25 x 25 squares.

Each square is then divided into two parts by diagonal stitching at different gradients.

The felt shapes are then inlayed into the rug's surface, according to a predetermined pattern.

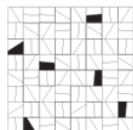
The border features the Punto Pettine.

This rug can be produced both with a single layer and a double layer of felt.

In the double-layer rug the underside is always without ornamentation and in one colour.

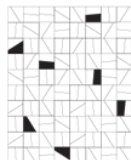
Only in rugs with a width higher than cm 200 the underside shows inner stitching.

T38D04 double layer



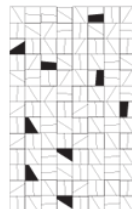
