


Tables

Material: legs in solid ash, natural or painted; crosspieces in steel tube painted in epoxy resin; joints in die-cast aluminium, sanded or painted in epoxy resin. Top in HPL.

Magis logo is stamped on each product of our collection vouching for their originality.



Legs: Natural Ash
Crosspieces: Grey
Joints: Sanded
Top: White 8500

Legs: Ash painted Black
Crosspieces + Joints: Black
Top: Black 8510
