Open container accessible around the entire perimeter thanks to a series of pivoting slats. Top and bottom in 19mm thick, contoured and with bevelled MDF, with the bottom part always lacquered with epoxy powder coating matt black, and top available veneered charcoal dyed oak or Stone Oak®, with bevelled edge always lacquered with epoxy powder coating matt black, or all matt black lacquered. Top available also in red Levanto or Sahara Noir marble (thickness 15mm), fixed to the MDF top through screws, with a satin finish and an opaque transparent prot slats, with ellipti fixed to the top a nylon and tie room and the room an

transparent protective varnish or a matt or glossy polyester finish. Slats, with elliptical $70 \times 16 \, \mathrm{mm}$ cross-section, in aluminium extrusion, fixed to the top and to the bottom by means of turned details in black nylon and tie rods. Slats available painted matt black, in charcoal dyed oak or Stone Oak®. Bridge legs, with elliptical cross-section feet, made in aluminum extrusion and steel sheet screwed together and always with matt black finish. Floor support secured by black contoured feet.

Notes

Stone Oak[®]: this wood owes its particular coloring to an entirely natural process. Because of this, some slabs may look more brown than others. Our commitment is to provide you a high quality product; any differences in color should not be considered as defects.

surface. Although this supplementary painting increases the surface resistance, it is still a natural material; therefore small superficial stains, due to oil or other substances, have to be promptly removed, before being absorbed in depth by the wood. Thus, we recommend regular care and maintenance.

On request, an additional protective (acrylic solvent) painting is available for the Stone Oak® finishing only. It should be noted that this additional coating slightly changes the natural color and texture of the
